From an ergonomic perspective, the evaluation of workers in different fields has already provided mature theories and a large number of research results. Some scholars have conducted a questionnaire survey on the health status of primary and secondary school teachers in Hong Kong, and found that, in addition to mental stress, work-related musculoskeletal disorders should also be valued [8].

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
