Lexical Analysis • A lexical analyzer collects input characters into groups (lexemes) and assigns an internal code (a token) to each group. • Lexemes are recognized by matching the input against patterns. • Tokens are usually coded as integer values, but for the sake of readability, they are often referenced through named constants.

names for syntax analysis. Functionality Lexical analysis reads the source program one character at a time and converts it into meaningful lexemes (tokens) whereas syntax analysis takes the tokens as input and generates a parse tree as output.
