He helped found Group f/64, an association of photographers advocating "pure" photography which favored sharp focus and the use of the full tonal range of a photograph. He and Fred Archer developed an exacting system of ...

Other major titles by Adams include My Camera in the National Parks (1950) and Photographs of the Southwest (1976). The Portfolios of Ansel Adams (1977) reproduced the 90 prints that Adams first published (between 1948 and 1976) as seven portfolios of original prints.

Tetons is among the rarest of Adams's large-format photographs due to the limited quantity ever printed. Only eight images were made from the Tetons negative in this mural size, and this one is rarified for its printing date of 1950, less than a decade after Adams captured the photo.

In 1941, Adams was asked to create photo murals of national parks and monuments to decorate the halls of the United States Department of Interior. One of the most praised works from the collection is The Tetons and the Snake River, taken at Grand Teton National Park, Wyoming in 1942.

**10 Facts About Pioneering Photographer Ansel Adams**

Born in 1902, Ansel Adams is best known for his images of the American National Parks, and of Yosemite in particular. Some of the other high-priced prints in the sale are his famous mural-sized prints. His picture of The Tetons and The Snake River, for instance, measures some 38x51 inches - and has an estimate of \$400,000-\$600,000.
