Combat stress reaction (CSR) is a term used within the military to describe acute behavioral disorganization seen by medical personnel as a direct result of the trauma of war. Also known as "combat fatigue" or "battle neurosis", it has some overlap with the diagnosis of acute stress reaction used in civilian psychiatry. It is historically linked to shell shock and can sometimes preclude post ...

### Combat And Operational Stress Control

Combat and operational stress control (COSC) comprises programs developed to prevent, identify and manage adverse COSRs in units; enhance mission performance; increase individual and unit resilience; conserve fighting strength; prevent or minimize adverse effects of combat stress on members' physical, psychological, behavioral, and social health; and return the unit or service member to duty.

Army Combat and Operational Stress Control (COSC) efforts seek to minimize the impact of stress on Soldiers' physical, psychological, behavioral, and social health as early as possible in order to promote mission readiness, increase individual and unit resilience, and enhance mission performance.

### Operational Stress Control (OSC) Awareness Brief

Combat and operational stress reactions (COSRs) are defined as "physical, emotional, cognitive, or behavioral reactions, adverse consequences, or psychological injuries of service members who have been exposed to stressful or traumatic events in combat or military operations," according to DoD Instruction 6490.05. COSRs can vary in severity depending on a variety of operational conditions ...

### Chapter 4 Combat and operational stress Control

Combat stress, sometimes called combat and operational stress or combat and operational stress reaction, is a common response to the mental and emotional effort active duty personnel exercise when facing tough and dangerous situations. Combat stress is similar to the muscle fatigue and soreness experienced after a tough physical workout.
