What is Fort Mose? More than 300 years ago, Africans escaped from enslavement in the British colony of Carolina. They fled southward toward Spanish St. Augustine. Through courage, persistence and ingenuity, they gained their freedom.

Fort Mose is located just two miles north of the center of St. Augustine, making it an easy side trip from the shops and restaurants of the historic downtown.
