

Grow It Indoors How To Make Houseplants Thrive

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Be aware of temperature, humidity, and ventilation. Most houseplants thrive in temperatures between 65 and 75°F during the day and about 10 degrees cooler at night. In general, houseplants require a level of humidity similar to that of their natural growing conditions.

The best way to propagate the plant is by seeds. Get it from a local garden shop or buy online and sow multiple seeds in a pot filled with seed mix. Water well and cover the pot with a plastic sheet and place it in bright, indirect light. The seeds will germinate in 2-4 weeks and in about 5-6 months, the plant will grow 1-2 feet tall.

Some herbs have unreliable germination rates, so you may want to use starter plants (established plants from a garden nursery) for indoor growing, or, sow more seeds than you hope to end up with. Basil is a good example of an unpredictable seed.

Soak the seeds for up to 8 hours in water. Fill a small bowl with just enough water to submerge the seeds completely. Pour all of the seeds you want to plant into the bowl and leave them alone for as long as 8 hours so they can absorb some moisture. That way, the seeds are more likely to germinate.
