By the end of World War II, 85 percent of the enlisted personnel assigned to Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps were women. On 7 June 1946, Commandant of the Marine Corps Gen Alexander A. Vandegrift approved the retention of a small number of women on active duty. They would serve as a trained nucleus for possible mobilization emergencies.
