African Americans in the Illinois General Assembly have had the longest uninterrupted presence in any state legislature in the United States, dating back to 1882. The first African American in the Illinois House of Representatives, John W. E. Thomas of Chicago, was elected in 1876, and after not being re-nominated in 1878 and 1880, returned to the House in 1882.

When Barack Obama was elected president in November 2008, a black American attained the nation's highest office for the first time in American history,.51 and a record number of African Americans now hold seats in the US Congress—both of which facts can certainly be regarded as another step forward in the continuing quest for black political empowerment.
