What is a total joint replacement? TMJ total joint replacement systems are artificial orthopedic devices and are used to replace a part of the body that has become painful, compromised and/ or no longer functions properly. In orthopedic terms, TMJ prosthetics are considered ball-and-socket joints that are made of 2 parts, the fossa and the condyle.

Alloplastic . The earliest report of an alloplastic implant in the temporomandibular joint is that by Eggers in 1946 whereby a foil made of tantalum was placed in between the surgically separated condyle and fossa of a 4-year-old child with ankylosis. 1 Christensen in 1960 2 developed an artificial fossa and then in 1973 3 developed a total prosthetic joint for the TMJ.

3.1 Total prosthetic replacement of the temporomandibular joint is considered when alternative treatments have failed. It involves replacing both the skull base component (the fossa or socket) and the condyle with prostheses. The aims of the procedure are to re-establish function of the temporomandibular joint and to relieve pain.

**Management of temporomandibular joint disorders: A surgeon ...**

Conservative treatments for disorders of the temporomandibular joint include rest, non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs, bite splints and physiotherapy. Surgical options include arthroscopic surgery, remodelling of the joint surface, removal of the intra-articular disc and replacement of components of the joint such as the disc, the fossa (socket) or the mandibular condyle.
