Best interests, etc., of person. 4.—(1) In making a decision under this Act concerning the care or treatment of a person (including a decision to make an admission order in relation to a person), the best interests of the person shall be the principal consideration with due regard being given to the interests of other persons who may be at risk of serious harm if the decision is not made.

The Mental Health Act 2001 was formally enacted by the Irish Houses of Oireachtas (parliament) on 8 July 2001 and implemented in full on 1 November 2006. The Mental Health Act 2001 replaces and updates a number of older pieces of legislation, including the Mental Treatment Act 1945.

One of the key functions of the Mental Health Act, 2001 is to provide people the right to have their involuntary detention automatically reviewed. This means that a persons' case will be reviewed by an independent group of people called a Mental Health Tribunal. This happens within 21 days of the person's admission.
